 - d. Photographs?
 - e. Artifacts?
 - f. Any other information?
4. If you have a living Survivor in your family, would they be willing to be interviewed?
5. If your family does not have a photo or testimonial media, would you still like to participate and donate your family's story in a written form?
6. Would you be willing to create a biography page about your family members who survived or perished in the Holocaust?
7. Would your family like to participate in this project by supplying information about your family's story?
