Dear fellow congregant:

In order to assist you during the coming year with your membership financial obligations, the following is a schedule and explanation of Bet Torah's dues and fees for the fiscal year July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021. As stated in Carol's note, Bet Torah is committed to the long-term relationship with our members and those who participate in our community. As each family navigates the impact of COVID-19, we want to make sure that everyone feels comfortable reaching out to Seth Young should you need additional support or flexibility in meeting your financial obligations.

#### **(1) Membership Dues**

---

Dues are billed 40% in July, 30% in August, and 30% in September  
Final payment is due by September 30, 2020.

- Family: \$3,063
- Single: \$1,740
- Senior: \$1,740
- Associate: \$305 (out-of-area membership)

#### **(2) Security Fee**

---

- Family, Senior & Single Members: \$200
- Non-Member Nursery School families: \$250

#### **(3) Building Maintenance Fund**

---

All new members: \$5,000 payable in installments spread over seven years:

- 1<sup>st</sup> year: \$500 due by January 31, 2021.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> years: \$750 per year due by January 31 each year until paid in full.

#### **(4) Nursery School**

---

- Billed separately in two installments due August 1, 2020 and October 1, 2020.

#### **(5) Bar/Bat Mitzvah Fees**

---

- Material & Tutoring Fee: billed when date is given and due in full upon acceptance of date: \$1,450.
- Kiddush Fee\*: two weeks prior to the event, you will be asked (will not be billed) to pay in full: \$1,675. If double B'nai Mitzvah: \$1,550 per family.
- Mincha/Rosh Chodesh Facilities Fee\*: \$590

\*Subject to using the Bet Torah building

**(6) Kulanu Tuition**

Deposit of \$775 is due upon receipt of registration in June. Balance is billed in full in July 2020 with 50% due August 1, 2020<sup>t</sup> and 50% due October 1, 2020.

Payment of the above may be made by check payable to Bet Torah. For both Nursery School and Kulanu, we are introducing electronic payment options, credit card or ACH/direct debit, to provide convenience and flexibility. Please note that associated transaction fees (3% for credit card and .75% for ACH/direct debit) will be passed through to you with either form of electronic payment.

Please be aware that in order to remain a member in good standing, you must be current with all dues and fees. As required by Bet Torah By-Laws, any member who is not in good standing may be denied use of the synagogue's facilities, High Holy Day tickets and, if applicable, might lose one's reserved Bar/Bat Mitzvah date.
