Science and Faith April 29-May 3, 2020

This course examines life, death, and resurrection through eyes of science and Christian faith. The goal is to reunite two divorced thought worlds, in order to see how faith and science can complement and illuminate each other. The practical aim is to increase our ability to do ministry with people whose worldview is strongly shaped by science and technology.

Russell Haitch, Professor of Theology and Human Science at Bethany Theological Seminary, will teach this course in an intensive format at Bethany in Richmond, IN. The course will include two additional sessions via Zoom technology.

This course is available to laypersons for personal enrichment (PF) and to clergy for continuing education. Continuing Education students will receive 2.0 CEUs. (See details below.)
