There will be a 3 prong approach to supporting the Pregnancy Center. You will be asked to assist through the material, volunteer and spiritual needs of the center.

1. Material needs: Provide for the material needs of the centers.-this could be any number of items: car seats, cribs, clothing, etc. There are centers who will need larger items for example office furniture, tv screens to use for the ultrasounds and more.

2. Volunteers: Provide for the volunteer needs of the centers. Women in the local PCCWs will be able to help with these as appropriate and following each center's volunteer screening process.

3. Spiritual Garden: Provide for the spiritual needs of the center. Each council will create spiritual garden for their adopted center and pray for the counselors, volunteers and people accessing the center. The suggested prayers are those used in spiritual bouquets.
