THERE WERE 9 DEANERIES. COMMITTEES WERE: STUDY CLUBS, LEGISLATION, PUBLICITY, HOSPITALITY, PTA, ORGANIZATION, EXECUTIVE

EARLY 1930'S DEPRESSION CAUSED HARDSHIP-MONEY PROBLEMS-DUES OF \$12.50 TO NATIONAL AND \$2.50 TO THE LINCOLN COUNCIL WERE HARD TO COLLECT SOME YEARS, AFFILIATION WOULD BE 100% AND THE NEXT YEAR WOULD BE A DROP. BISHOP KUCERA OFFERED TO PAY HALF THE DUES IF THE ORGANIZATION WOULD JOIN, BUT EVEN WITH THAT INDUCEMENT GETTING AFFILIATES WAS STILL THE HARDEST JOB OF THE COUNCIL.

1934 DIOCESAN PRESIDENT WROTE TO NATIONAL, "WE HAVE MADE A VALIANT EFFORT THIS FALL, BUT THINGS ARE SO GLOOMY HERE FINANCIALLY THAT IT HAS BEEN VERY DIFFICULT TO DO WHAT WE SHOULD LIKE TO DO, AND WHAT YOU WOULD LIKE US TO DO, IF WE HAD THE MONEY."
