Bishop's Project: Diocesan Archives

The Diocesan Museum has been in storage for the past 6 years. It contains documents and archives and museum items pertaining to the parishes, schools, hospitals, institutions, priests, religious communities and other items documenting the history of the Diocese of Lincoln. The money collected for the Bishop's Project can help purchase suitable display cases and make the history of the Diocese available to the public.

President's Project: Catholic Social Services Hastings and St. Gianna West

Each of the 13 Deaneries of the Diocese will present a check (at the Convention) to CSS Hastings for the needs of the people served by the Hastings CSS. Part of the money will be used for the expenses of St. Gianna West to provide for the needs of women and children seeking safety from abuse. These funds will help individuals who live in the western part of the State.

There are about 20 parishes west of Holdrege that benefit from this ministry. Father Bernard Lorenz travels to these parishes and homes bringing Christ to these Spanish speaking people. Donations would be used to purchase Bibles, Catechisms and printing other information for the Hispanic population.
