• Include the following information in the body of the email:

- Title of project
- Names of all authors (last names first, followed by initials, with credentials abbreviated (MD, PhD, MPT, OT, etc), with the presenting author(s) underlined
- Email address and telephone number of contact
- Indicate if you are submitting for an oral presentation, poster or either
- Acknowledgement of any financial support for the project

FORMATTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Insert an abstract (saved as a word file with the research project title only) to this email. Limit the word count to 500 words not including title and authors.

For Reports of Original Data include the following sections: Background/Purpose, Participants, Design and Setting, Interventions (if relevant), Results, Conclusions

For Case Reports include the following sections: Background/Purpose, Case Description, Outcomes, Interventions (if relevant), Discussion/Conclusion
