During difficult times, I find consolation in reflecting upon the visible signs of God's abundant blessings in my life. Your faithful participation in parish life is an expression of those blessings. Know that I am grateful to you during these extraordinary times. My daily prayers are for you, asking God to keep you well, and to bring His abiding love to you during these difficult times.

Here at St. Bernardine, ministry is different but unceasing. We remain a faithful community, and we continue to do our best to meet the spiritual needs of our parishioners in numerous ways: outdoor Masses, drive through confession and communion services, livestreamed Masses, with communication to parishioners via Facebook, our parish website, Constant Contact emails, and bulletins, to name a few.

Aside from the usual needs of keeping the lights on, I also have the responsibility to maintain the staff at the parish and to continue our ministries. With the COVID-19 restrictions placed on our church, we have seen our weekly offerings plunge. As such, I have had to take strong measures in reducing our parish's expenses which includes cutting hours and laying off staff, reducing and eliminating non-essential repairs to our buildings, and providing the most basic services for our ministries.
