HOW IT WORKS

RESIDENT TREE BUYING PROGRAM

\$205-\$440 PER TREE DELIVERED AND PLANTED

- Residents pick trees from a list of available options
- Price includes delivery and installation on your property on a date determined by the Borough and Fernbrook in mid-October.
- Residents do not need to be present for planting but it is highly encouraged.
- Trees are guaranteed for 1-year.
- Residents may order as many trees as desired.
- Planting locations will be informed by utility mark-outs to ensure nothing is planted by gas or water lines.
- **Residents are responsible for marking sprinkler lines.**
- No planting in the Borough right-of-way.
- Participating residents will make payment directly to Fernbrook Nursery on the day of planting(s) and make checks payable to "Fernbrook Nursery".

GUARANTEE

All plants shall be guaranteed to be in a satisfactory growing condition and to live for a period of 1 year from planting except in raised pots or planters, plants under any overhang, plants receiving mechanical damage, plants damaged by an act of God, plants subject to extreme weather conditions not typical of the area. All plants that fail to survive under the guarantee shall be replaced once at the end of the guarantee period with the same type and size as originally specified. The cost of replacement shall be for the labor only on an hourly basis. No cost shall be charged for the plant material.



SHADE TREES

Red Sunset Maple



Red Sunset is a cold-hardy red maple with superior fall color and good branch structure. Winter buds, clusters of small winter spring flowers, leaf stems, twigs, and winged summer fruits are all reddish colored. The glossy green leaves persist on the tree turning orange-red to brilliant red in the fall. Red Sunset grows moderately fast, 45'-50' high with a 35'-40' spread. Full sun to partial shade.

This is a native tree.

Skyline Honeylocust

The honeylocust develops a strong pyramidal canopy with fine-textured leaves that cast light, filtered shade, **allowing lawn and plants to grow beneath it.** Tolerant of urban conditions and highly adaptable. Moderate growth rate to about 35-45' high and 25-35' wide. Full sun. **This is a native tree.**

Bi-Color White Oak



Bi-Color White Oak is considered one of the best oaks for residential landscapes. Dark green leaves with silvery undersides shimmer in the breeze and turn yellow to bronze in the fall. Adaptable to both wet and dry soils once established. Moderate growth rate reaching 50–60' with a broad rounded crown. This is delivered as smaller size which means it should establish itself quicker. Full sun. **This is a native tree highly prized for it's value to wildlife and stormwater mitigation.**

London Planetree

The Buttonwood Road Tree!

Urban shade tree with cream, olive, and gray bark that sheds annually and an upright pyramidal form. Very durable and tolerates many conditions once established. Moderately fast-growing, reaching 35–45' high with a 25–35' spread. Full sun.

Greenspire Littleleaf Linden

Greenspire Linden is pyramidal shade tree with dense foliage and fragrant pale-yellow flowers in early spring that attract bees and other pollinators. These are good street trees (check for overhead wires first) and will create a uniform-neat look if planted along path, driveway or street. Moderate growth rate reaching 40-50' high and 25-35' wide. Full sun to partial shade.

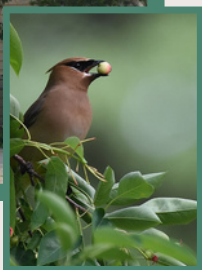
Green Pillar Pin Oak

Green Pillar Oak is a narrow, upright oak selected for sites where canopy width is limited. Its glossy green leaves turn bright red in the fall and its strong vertical form works well along driveways or in smaller front yards. Growth is moderately fast and will reach 40-50' tall but only 12-15' wide. Full sun. **This is a native oak with high value to wildlife.**

FLOWERING TREES



Allegheny Serviceberry

A graceful multi-season favorite with delicate white flowers in early spring before leaves emerge. Edible purple berries attract birds in early summer. Foliage turns orange to red in fall. Upright oval habit reaching 15–25'. Full sun to partial shade. **This native tree is highly beneficial to birds and pollinators.**

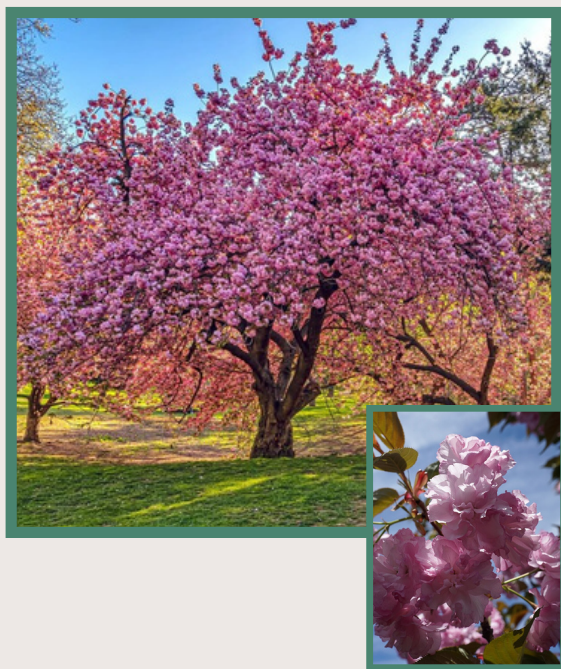
Sweetbay Magnolia

This is a refined native tree with glossy dark green leaves with silver undersides and creamy white, lemon-scented flowers from late spring to summer. Red-seeded fruit later attracts birds. Moderate growth rate reaching 15–30' high and 10–20' wide. Full sun to partial shade. **This is a native flowering evergreen.**

Kwanzan Cherry

The Fair Haven Road Tree!

Known for its stunning double pink blossoms in spring. Vase-shaped form creates beautiful structure along streets and walkways. Foliage turns bronze to orange in fall. Moderate growth reaching 30–36'. Full sun.

Cherokee Chief Flowering Dogwood

Cherokee Chief is a compact native understory tree with rich ruby-red flowers in spring, red fruit for birds, and burgundy-red fall foliage. It performs best with morning sun or partial shade, protected from afternoon sun. Mulch the root zone and provide good air circulation. Growth rate is slow-moderate reaching 15–25' high and wide. **This is a native tree beneficial to birds.**

FLOWERING TREES



Cascading Hearts Eastern Red Bud

Cascading hearts is a compact weeping redbud with arching branches, lavender-pink flowers, and heart-shaped leaves. It's an ideal specimen tree near a patio or small garden. Growth is slow to moderate, reaching 8-12' high and wide. Plant in full sun to partial shade. **This is a native tree.**

Flamethrower Eastern Red Bud

Flamethrower Red Bud combines lavender-pink spring flowers with striking multi-color foliage. New leaves emerge red, then shift through orange and yellow to green often displaying several colors at once. Full sun with afternoon shade is best. Moderate growth rate reaching 15-20' high and 15-20' wide. **This is a native tree.**

EVERGREEN TREES

Elegantissima Arborvitae

Dense, conical evergreen with soft green foliage tipped in creamy yellow. Provides year-round color and works well as a hedge or specimen. Moderate growth reaching 15–25' tall with a 6–10' spread. Full sun.

*this one is taller and wider than the Emerald Green



Emerald Green Arborvitae

A narrow, pyramidal evergreen with rich emerald foliage that holds its color through winter. Ideal for screening and privacy. Slow to moderate growth reaching 10–15' with a 2–3' spread. Full sun to partial shade.

*this one is better for tight spaces

FRUIT TREES

Gala Apple



Gala is an apple known for crisp, sweet, aromatic fruit with red-orange striping. Plant in full sun with good air circulation and fertile well drained soil. Moderate growth rate, commonly kept 12-18' high and wide. Regular pruning, thinning, and disease monitoring are important for success. **This is a self pollinating tree.**

Moonglow Pear

Moonglow is a European pear cultivar producing large, smooth, yellow-green fruit with mild-juicy flesh. Good blight resistance compared with other pears. Plant in full sun with good air circulation and fertile well drained soil. Growth is moderate and semi-dwarf trees mature at 12-18' and 10-15' wide. **This is a self pollinating tree.**

GATOR BAG - \$20



Gator bags help you deep water a tree which is the best way to water a newly planted tree (or any new planting). Deep watering is more effective at reaching the roots. Gator bags slowly release water into the ground and allow your new tree to absorb the water instead of it running off as may happen when watering with a hose.

DEER PROTECTION - \$10

Protect your new tree from deer rubbing. A deer rub describes the abrasions caused by a male deer rubbing his forehead and antlers against the base of a tree and usually starts in late summer-early fall. **This can lead to the death of a young tree** because the bark is still soft and the rubbing will expose the layer that helps move nutrients through the tree. **This is an upgrade from previous tree wraps that were offered.**
