

Meaningful Work for Everyone #PGDay1: Gillette 14 Day Work Experience

Procter and Gamble is offering two paid work-experience placement positions for individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder. Individuals will be invited to join the Research & Development Team at the World Shaving Headquarters in Boston for a 14-day work experience with flexibility on hours/week based on the individual, built in.

We strongly welcome applications from candidates who do not have a traditional employment or education history or who have experienced difficulties in gaining previous work experience. This means we do not require any formal qualifications or previous work experience. However, candidates should have interest in design, engineering, science, or creative thinking.

Requirements

All candidates should be 18 or older and have:

- Communication skills that involve asking questions, ability to receive feedback and modify one's workplace performance (this could be through use of communication aids- ie: ipad)
- The ability to make plans for their own travel to and from the site in Boston
- The ability to work independently, through guidance and without the support of an onsite job coach

Application

To ensure the role is fully accessible, applicants can apply by submitting either a written or visual application:

- Written Application (choose 1 or both):
 - ◊ Resume and cover letter
 - ◊ Work sample that displays your unique strengths (e.g. paper, class assignment, code writing)
- Video Application (choose 1 or both):
 - ◊ Video that describes your unique strengths and reasons for applying
 - ◊ Work sample that displays your unique strengths (e.g. animation, drawings, designs)

Interview

There will be no formal face to face interview. Instead there will be a work experience selection day where candidates will have the opportunity to show their unique strengths and talents by participating in different projects and tasks.

Pay and Expenses

Travel expenses to and from the Boston site from 50 miles away or less, will be paid for all applicants attending the interview day upon evidence of valid receipts.

Those selected for the 14-day work experience will be paid a set rate \$120/day for the 14 days.

Please note that those candidates who have been selected to take part in the 14-day work experience program will need to complete additional onboarding requirements after the experiential day on the June 18th.

All applications must be received by May 21, 2018. Candidates will be informed of whether they have been invited to the interview day by June 8, 2018
