## PRESS RELEASE San Juan County, Colorado

Silverton Colo.; The Silverton community has seen a spike in COVID-19 exposures, reports of illness and COVID-19 positive cases in the last 3 days.

We are moving into further restrictions, "Safer at Home" LEVEL 3. [Safer at Home Public Health Order](#),

- Public and private gatherings are limited to no more than 10 individuals from no more than two different households.
- Non-critical Retail may operate at 25% of the posted occupancy limit.
- Personal Services may operate at 25% of the posted occupancy limit, not to exceed 25 people, per room.
- Restaurants may operate at 25% of the posted occupancy limit indoors not to exceed 50 people excluding staff, whichever is less, per room.
- Houses of worship and Life Rites may operate at 25% or 50 people. For outdoor worship services, a house of worship must maintain 6 feet distance between non-household members
- Indoor events may operate at 50 percent capacity or 25 people, whichever is fewer.
- Recreation
  - 1. Gyms, recreation centers and indoor pools are not authorized to open for in-person services; virtual services may be provided.
  - 2. Outdoor recreational activities in groups of 10 people or fewer may occur, maintaining 6 feet Distancing Requirements between non-household contacts.

#### GUIDELINES AND RESTRICTIONS

<b>P-12 Schools</b> Remote or hybrid suggested, limited in-person as appropriate	<b>Group Sports</b> Virtual, or outdoors in groups less than 10
<b>Higher Education</b> Remote or hybrid suggested, limited in-person as appropriate	<b>Retail</b> 25% capacity
<b>Places of Worship</b> 25% capacity or 50 people 6ft between parties outdoors, per local zoning	<b>Personal Services</b> 25% capacity or 25 people
<b>Restaurants</b> 25% capacity or 50 people 6ft between parties outdoors, per local zoning	<b>Indoor Events</b> 25 person cap (with calculator)
<b>Offices</b> 25% capacity	<b>Outdoor Events</b> 75 person cap (with calculator)
<b>Bars</b> Closed	<b>Senior Facilities</b> Closed except for compassionate visitation
<b>Gyms/Fitness</b> 25% capacity or 25 people	<b>Outdoor Recreation</b> 25% capacity or 10 people
