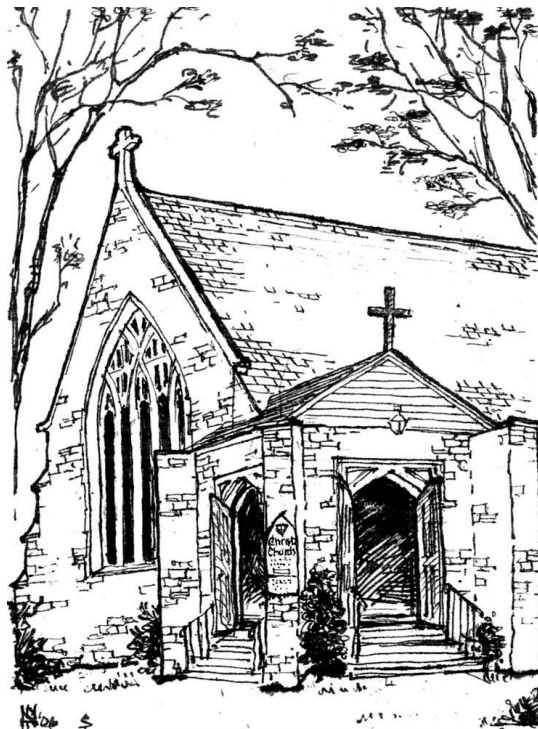

Thrift Shoppe - This week, Vestry approved the Thrift Shoppe designation of \$2500 from proceeds to the Plymouth Salvation Army. This outreach will be specifically earmarked for the Salvation Army's Summer Camp Wonderland scholarships. Camp Wonderland, instituted in 1924, is an overnight camp located in Sharon, housed on 110 acres of woodlands on Lake Massapoag. It provides memorable camping experiences that encompass physical, social, and spiritual guidance for hundreds of Massachusetts children. The Salvation Army is committed to ensuring every child the opportunity to attend camp. The scholarship money provided will specifically support children of need from Plymouth, Kingston, and Carver. We are grateful to the many volunteers, donors, and shoppers who make community outreach possible.
