

Research Study: Call for participants!

Study Title: The impact of an intensive activities-based locomotor training program on activity capacity, performance, and participation in children with cerebral palsy

WHO: Children with cerebral palsy between 2 and 6 years old who want to participate in a 3-week intensive program at Fortis Therapy Center

WHAT: Children will participate in a free Activities-Based Locomotor Training program at Fortis Therapy Center. Therapy sessions will last for 3 hours/day, 5 days/week for 3 weeks. A physical therapist will perform assessments 4 times (about 75 minutes each):

1. The first day of the program
2. The last day of the program
3. Three weeks after the end of the program
4. Three weeks after the child has resumed their usual therapy



WHY: We want to investigate the impact of an intensive 3-week activities-based locomotor training program on activity capacity, activity performance, and participation in children with cerebral palsy. This information will help physical therapists decide if this type of program is helpful for their clients.
