We evaluated this property and developed conceptual site layouts as part of the Duke Site Readiness Program in 2013. In 2016, Enjoy Life Foods began manufacturing allergy-friendly and gluten-free products in a 200,000-square-foot facility on the site; creating jobs for over 100 people.


