# **Operational Guidelines**

#### Clients

- Start with 15-18 clients a day (we do have some alternating clients to average 15 a day), and gradually build
  - Two major prerequisites:
    - Heightened infection-control measures are put into place and become routine
    - Personal protective equipment supplies are re-stocked and readily available
- Client selection based on
  - Caregiver needs
  - Center's ability to care for client
  - Client's health risk factors

### **Transportation**

- Starts at 7 a.m. (only 15 minutes later than traditional time)
  - Only one client in each seat
  - Wheelchairs will need to be staggered
  - Buses must be sanitized with approved solution using approved practices after each morning route and each afternoon route, including:
  - o Rails
  - o Seats
  - Arm rest
  - Head rest
- Drivers must wear masks
- Clients who can wear a mask on the bus will be encouraged to do so

#### Infection Control

### Infection control standards have increased

- Coronavirus can survive different times on different surfaces:
  - 48 hours on cardboard
  - 4 hours on copper/metals
  - 3 hours in the air
- Staff will require additional training for infection control

- Masks must be worn by staff at all times
  - Encourage clients to wear masks donated or purchased from local seamstress but not reasonable
- Personal-care staff will not be allowed to wear any personal clothing
  - Scrubs are only permissible attire
  - Scrub jacket may be included
- Activity staff will be required to wear simple attire (SarahCare T-shirts allowed)
- Staff is strongly encouraged to bring additional clothes to change into before leaving for home.
  - Daytime/work clothing should be bagged and washed immediately after returning home
- No casual Fridays until further notice
- Staff must wash hands using approved guidelines every 20 minutes or when changing an activity

### **Client best practices**

- ALL clients must have temperature taken before entering center
  - o Anyone with temperature of 100 degrees or higher will be sent home
- Encourage families to take client temperature before client get on the bus
  - This should reduce sending clients home
  - Should also reduce opportunities for infection to virus to spread on bus
- · Client who has shown a fever can only return
  - When they have been without a fever for 24 hours
  - Have a physician's note stating they can return
  - Social distancing at a minimum of 6 feet must be strictly enforced at all times
    - Clients most likely will require more than 6 feet because they likely are not capable of judging accurate distance
    - This also will reduce client-to-client physical contact.
- Only one client at each table
- Lounge chairs must be assigned to one client
  - o Blankets must be labeled with client's name
    - Only one blanket for each client
    - Client must use assigned blanket
- No shower services until further notice
- Client hands must be washed every 20 minutes or when changing an activity

#### **Daily Activities**

- Each client must have personal bin with a Ziplock bag with their supplies.
  - Activities must comply with 6-foot social distancing guideline
  - Supplies use in an activity must be sanitized immediately after use
  - All supplies used during the day must be sanitized at the end of each day

#### Meal service

- Each table must go through three-step sanitization process before and after meal
- Tables also must be sanitized each day before clients arrive and after clients leave
- Sanitization process:
  - Wash table with soap and water
  - Rinse table
  - Spray or wipe table with disinfectant
    - Do **not** wipe off; disinfectant much be allowed to air dry
  - Use only disposable plates and utensils

#### Personal Care

- Masks must be worn by staff (and client if possible) during process
- Staff must wash hands following approved guidelines before personal care process begins
- All waste from each personal care process must be immediately tied in a plastic bag
- Waste must be disposed of immediately before performing personal care on another client
- Staff must again wash hands using approved guidelines after performing personal care on a client and disposing of that client's waste

## Laundry Services

- o **All** laundry must be cleaned with the washer on a sanitize/hot cycle
- Temperature should be as hot as possible for the type of fabric being washed
  - Typically between 140-190 degrees
