

2020 Travel Tips & What to Expect at the Airport

If you need to fly, the following travel tips may help travelers during a typically busy season.



Please allow extra time for parking, checking-in, and going through security. Arrive at the airport at least 90 minutes before your boarding time for all domestic flights.



Short-term (ExpressXE) and long-term (StandardXE) parking options are available, both located close to the terminal.



Touch-less parking can be booked on-line at www.skyxe.ca. Bookings must be done at least 24 hours in advance. Upon booking, a confirmation email will be sent with a QR code that will allow access based on the date and time entered in the booking. Codes can be printed or scanned from mobile devices at each parking lot entrance and exit. [Click here](#) to see how it works.

Research any checked baggage restrictions and costs with your airline.



Make sure to keep any gifts unwrapped. Wrapped gifts may need to be unwrapped when going through security so plan to wrap presents at your destination.

Skyxe is reminding the community to minimize group size when coming into the terminal to pick-up friends and family. For quick passenger pick-up or drop off, please use our cell phone parking lot and proceed to the public curb after your guest has let you know they have their bags.

Traffic flow has been adjusted in and out of the terminal to ensure one-way traffic areas.

The Government of Saskatchewan has mandated the use of non-medical masks in indoor places in Saskatoon, including airports.

Guests are also required to wear non-medical masks through screening and aboard aircraft.

Upon entry, guests are asked to use the hand sanitizer stations that are located at each entrance of the building. Additional hand sanitizer stations can be found throughout the terminal.



Guests can check-in with their individual airlines on-line 24 hours prior to their departure. Alternately, kiosks are available for self check-in and/or baggage tag printing upon arrival at the airport.

Touch-less self-serve bag drops are available for guests to drop off their own checked bags for all Air Canada and WestJet flights.

Expanded lines have been established in pre-board screening to allow for social distancing.

Physical distancing floor decals are placed throughout the terminal to remind passengers to maintain 2 meters between each other.



Temperature checks are in place at the entrance of pre-board screening, and are mandatory for all traveling guests.

Once you return to Saskatoon, proceed to receive your bags in our arrival area. Baggage carts can be wiped down with disinfectant wipes located next to the baggage carts.
