

Salaam Alaikum,

The weekend of September 28-29th and October 5th 2019, a Teachers Skills Program (TSP) was held in Montreal for teachers, assistants, resource team and parents of the SHIA Madrasah. The intensive 3-day training event was delivered to 22 participants, by the head of the Madrasah Centre of Excellence TSP Program, Sayyid Aliraza Naqvi from Birmingham, UK.

The objective of the Teaching Skills Program, which includes the Micro Teach Sessions, is to equip teachers with different methods of teaching to enhance student understanding, increase the skills of the teachers in understanding different personalities and to shift their attitudes and behaviors so that they are able to support the learning of the students. The long-term plan is to provide every teacher who has gone through the program with the opportunity to experience five sessions of Micro-teaching. Upon completion of the course, TSP-trained teachers will be presented with a University accredited certificate.
