

PHOTOGRAPHY, VIDEOGRAPHY, AND MEDIA CONSENT NOTICE

By purchasing a ticket to, registering for, or otherwise entering or attending the 2026 Metro Boat Show (the "Event"), you acknowledge and agree as follows:

1. Consent to Recording. The Event premises are subject to ongoing photography, audio recording, videography, live-streaming, and other forms of visual and audio capture (collectively, "Recordings") by the Event organizer, its sponsors, exhibitors, vendors, contractors, and media partners (collectively, the "Producing Parties"), using any current or future technology or medium, including but not limited to still cameras, video cameras, drones, body cameras, security and surveillance systems, mobile devices, and webcasting equipment.

2. Grant of Rights. By entering the Event, you irrevocably consent to being photographed, filmed, recorded, and/or otherwise captured, and you grant to the Producing Parties a perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free, transferable, sublicensable, and irrevocable right and license to use, reproduce, distribute, publicly display, publicly perform, broadcast, edit, modify, create derivative works from, and otherwise exploit your name, voice, image, likeness, appearance, statements, and any vessels, vehicles, equipment, products, or other goods you bring to, display at, or associate with the Event ("Your Goods"), in any Recordings, in any medium now known or hereafter devised (including print, broadcast, digital, social media, and internet), for any purpose, including without limitation advertising, marketing, promotional, editorial, archival, and commercial purposes, without further notice, compensation, review, or approval.

3. No Compensation; No Approval Rights. You acknowledge that your appearance, and any depiction of Your Goods, in any Recordings is voluntary and incidental to your attendance, and that you are not entitled to any compensation, royalty, credit, or approval right in connection with any use of the Recordings.

4. Waiver of Claims. You release and forever discharge the Producing Parties, and their respective officers, directors, employees, and agents, from any and all claims, demands, causes of action, or liability of any kind arising from or related to the use of the Recordings, including without limitation claims for invasion of privacy, right of publicity, defamation, or infringement of any intellectual property or proprietary rights, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

5. Minors. Any individual under the age of 18 may only be photographed or recorded with the consent of a parent or legal guardian, who by bringing or permitting the minor to attend the Event, provides such consent on the minor's behalf and agrees to the terms above on the minor's behalf.

6. Scope and Duration. This consent applies throughout the Event premises, including entrances, exhibit areas, docks, marinas, parking areas, and any other area designated as part of the Event, and survives the conclusion of the Event indefinitely.

7. No Right to Object. Attendance at the Event constitutes acceptance of this notice. Individuals who do not wish to be photographed or recorded should not enter the Event premises; the Producing Parties are under no obligation to accommodate individual requests to avoid or delete Recordings.
