Water Main Replacement Overview

The City of Glendale is replacing existing water lines with new water lines and service connections in the area shown on the map. Work will start the week of Monday, May 13, 2024 through September 2024. This infrastructure upgrade will be performed by the City's contractor, Auza Contracting, Inc.

Short periods of water service interruption may be necessary to tie in the new services. You will be notified at least 48 hours in advance of any service interruptions.


Traffic Restrictions

Due to the nature of this work, drivers will experience traffic restrictions within the construction work zone, but significant effort will be made to keep as many lanes open as practical to allow the work to be completed on or ahead of schedule.

- Starting Monday, May 13, 2024, full road closures of 55th Avenue will impact neighborhood traffic. See alternate route on map. Work will be done one block at a time.
- Work hours are 7 a.m. 5 p.m. Monday through Friday, although some night and/or weekend work may be necessary.
- Access to business and residences will be restricted but maintained.
- On-street parking may be restricted as necessary to complete the work. The City will provide advance notice of any such restrictions.
- Crews will not work the entire area at once; however the entire area will be considered a construction zone, so your patience and attention to safety are appreciated!
