

Saturday afternoon at the movies

1. HOW IT WORKS:

Each Wednesday, Mel Washburn sends an email to all members of the Group. This e-mail selects one of the films being shown at the Landmark Century Cinema (2828 N. Clark St.) and suggests a time on the following Saturday when members of the Group will gather to watch the movie. On that Saturday members come to the Cinema and watch the movie. After the film, they gather in the bar/lounge area of the theater for a self-hosted beverage and lively discussion of the movie.

2. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- a. How do I get my name on the e-mail list? Answer: Send an e-mail to melville.washburn@outlook.com asking to be added to list. You will then begin receiving the e-mail each Wednesday.
- b. How do I buy my ticket? Answer: you can buy it on-line on the Landmark Theater website or you can buy it at the box office on the day of the show. The ticket price for seniors is \$10.
- c. How do I find the group after the movie? Answer: go to the bar after the show and look for a group of grey-haired people. There are usually six or so of us. Don't be shy: just introduce yourself. We love to meet new people and hear their ideas.
- d. Do I have to have a drink? Answer: No, you don't. However, the bar has a very nice selection of wines and beers at reasonable prices. They also provide glasses of water for free. So, there's no reason to go thirsty.
- e. Do I have to go to the movie every Saturday? Answer: No. Many people on the e-mail list have never come to the showing. If and when they do come, they will be welcome. We NEVER take anyone's name off the list unless they request.
