## BRUSHING

Before bathing your pet, gently brush and detangle their hair with an appropriate grooming tool that's intended for their coat. Contact your local veterinarian or groomer to get information on the best types of brushes or combs to use.

## BATH TIME

Place a towel or bath mat in your bathtub or sink underneath your pet's feet. Wet coat thoroughly with warm water. Clean with one of our moisturizing natural shampoos and conditioners and then rinse. 


## PAW PROTECTION & CLEANING
