### LYME DISEASE IN PETS

A tick bite can cause Lyme disease. If left untreated Lyme disease in pets can spread to the joints, heart and nervous system. In most cases, it can be treated with antibiotics.



### WHERE TICKS HIDE

Inspect your pets when you've been outside. Ticks like to hide under the collar, under the tail, inside the groin area, between the toes, under the front legs and at the elbow. They also hide on a pet's eye lids and ear flaps.



### REMOVING TICKS

Wear latex gloves and use tweezers to pull the tick straight out. Do not twist the tick and make sure it's fully removed. Disinfect the area with rubbing alcohol, antibiotic spray or wipe.



### SAFE PREVENTION
