When does e-learning start?

- Monday, April 13. Make sure your scholar is ready to learn!

What does my scholar need for remote learning?

- Your scholar will need a computer or tablet.
- Your scholar will need internet access.
- Your scholar will need a quiet place to focus on learning every day.

Where does my scholar find this information?

- Everything for e-learning is in Google Classroom (classroom.google.com). Your scholar should have an invitation to their grade level classroom in their Rowe email. Reach out to your teacher if you cannot find this information.
- We will review expectations for online learning with all scholars the first week.

What is the schedule?

- In elementary school (K-5), scholars will not have a timed schedule like the middle school does.
- You can treat each day like a "checklist" and just make sure everything in their google classroom gets done for the day, at whatever time of day that works for your family.
- If your family would like a little more structure and/or a schedule, here are charts for K-2 and 3-5:
