Georgia's Adopt-a-Stream program allows citizens to both **observe** the conditions of our local streams and become **aware of pollution** and **water quality** issues in our area.

Peachtree Corners has **three** of its **own impaired streams** that are **not meeting** the state's water quality **standards**. That's why we need **YOUR** help!

Gwinnett Clean and Beautiful will help you get started, providing supplies, trainings, and guidance! But **you** will serve as official "**keepers**" of a portion of a creek or stream by periodically **monitoring its condition**.

2. Get to know your waterway

Look at the area around the waterway. If you see a lot of trash, your waterway might need regular cleanups. If you see or smell anything unusual, you might want to check your waterway's health.
