Recycling your Christmas tree keeps trees out of landfills by recycling them into mulch. This effort saves precious landfill space and provides an easy and environmentally conscious solution for residents.

Drop off your Christmas tree to be recycled and it will be turned into mulch!

## Christmas Tree Curbside Pickup by Waste Management

- Takes place for the full two (2) weeks after Christmas.
- Pickup will be the same day as your scheduled service day.
- Trees must be less than six (6) feet. If over six (6) feet must be cut in half.
- Note: The trees picked up curbside are **not** recycled. Due to not being recycled they can have tinsel/garland left on them but no ornaments or anything that can fall off littering the sidewalks/streets.
- The last day of pickup will be January 10, 2020.

**Customers with a Yard Waste Account:** One tree per week at no additional charge.

**Customers without a Yard Waste Account:** Will need to call in and schedule a bulk pickup of their Christmas tree for a fee of \$25.00.
