Looking for Ways to Help Your Community?
Help Install Bricks, Other Projects at Veterans Monument

The Monument is built and has been open for nearly a year – but there is still some work to be done! We need some volunteer assistance with projects this Spring and through the Fall.

1. INSTALL 47 NEW BRICKS ON THE MONUMENT. We will use volunteers to install the new bricks. PCVMA will provide instruction, tools needed, and refreshments.
 - a. WHEN & WHERE: Week of May 18 at the Monument. Specific date and time to be established (after bricks are delivered)
 - b. WHAT: Remove existing blank bricks and install engraved ones (no more than three hours).
 - c. NUMBER OF VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: At least ten but we will have work for anyone who shows up.
 - d. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Be able to carry bricks, bend over or kneel, and use provided tools to remove and install bricks.

2. ASSIST WITH THE MEMORIAL DAY CEREMONY ON MONDAY, MAY 25. Our ceremony will have two parts.
 - a. PART 1: Meet at the Monument at 6:15 AM to be part of the detail to lower the flags to half-mast at daylight (approximately 6:30). Following the flag lowering we will adjourn for coffee at Starbucks (unless something else is open in the Town Center).
 - b. PART 2: Meet at the Monument at 11:00 to serve as ushers for the 11:30 ceremony and/or guides on the Monument to explain its features and assist people with finding bricks.

It involves raising funds, working with Boy and/or Girl Scouts to locate Veteran graves, and recruiting volunteers to lay the wreaths when they arrive in December.
