Restaurant with Dog-friendly Patio to Open in Town Center

Joining the growing list of eateries at the city's Town Center is California-based [Lazy Dog Restaurant & Bar](#), known for its pet-friendly accommodations. Scheduled to open in the spring 2019, it will be the first metro location to open in the Atlanta metro area.

The 8,000 square-foot restaurant will include a 1,400 square-foot outdoor patio and features a fire pit and lounge. Dogs on leashes will be welcome on the patio.

The interior offers cozy fireplaces and rustic mountain-themed decor. A variety of starters, small plates, salads, burgers, pizza, chicken, steak and fish, desserts, non-alcoholic beverages and an array of beers, wines and cocktails are available. The dog menu includes a complimentary bowl of water. In addition, three food items ranging from \$2.50 to \$4.95 are available for purchase.

The freestanding building will face Peachtree Parkway and will be located adjacent to the Town Center entrance. Lazy Dog has 26 restaurants in California, Colorado, Nevada and Texas. The Peachtree Corners location is the first this side of the Mississippi. Lazy Dog is privately owned and was founded in 2003 by Chris Simms, Gabe Caliendo, Steve Price, and Roshan Mendis.
