What is City's Ordinance on Fallen, Dead Trees on Residential Property

With the most recent dramatic changes in weather, Gwinnett County and the City of Peachtree Corners have seen an influx of calls regarding trees. These calls vary in type ranging from fallen trees, dead and/or hazardous trees to tree debris that has fallen due to rain, wind, or ice. The City of Peachtree Corners does have codes that address all these scenarios.

It is a violation of Peachtree Corners Code to have a dead tree on your property that poses a danger to person or property on an adjacent lot. Any tree debris that has fallen is to be removed from the property within 14 days.

If a tree must be removed or has fallen, the City does not allow the stumps to stand taller than 12" from ground level. If any of these situations are applicable to a property within the City of Peachtree Corners, please contact your local Code Enforcement Team at 470.395.7026.
