Tech Park Office Buildings to be Converted to Trendy Loft Office Space

An Atlanta developer has new plans for the old Honeywell building in Technology Park.

Parkside Partners announced recently it will convert the four 45-year-old existing office buildings, located at 125 Technology Parkway, to trendy loft office space complete with a multi-function green space to be used for outdoor meetings or just casual conversations with colleagues.

Built in the early 1970s, the former Honeywell complex's nearly 100,000 square-feet will be converted to creative loft offices with exposed brick and high ceilings.

Parkside Partners has named its development "The Bureau" and is working with Brock Hudgins Architects in designing the 8-acre project that will include a 1-acre amenity park located in the center of the four buildings named "The Quad."

Tenants in the new loft-office development will have access to the city's new multi-use trail system which will link Technology Park to the new Town Center and to the nearby millennial housing development, [Echo Lakeside](#).
