City Ordinances Regarding Inoperative, Unlicensed Vehicles

The City of Peachtree Corners has ordinances in place pertaining to vehicles regarding issues such as current license/tag, in-operable vehicles and parking surfaces.

It is prohibited per city ordinance for the owner or resident of any property in the city limits to allow any of the following to accumulate: no inoperative or unlicensed motor vehicle shall be parked, kept or stored on any premises, and no vehicles shall at any time be in a state of major disassembly, disrepair, or in the process stripped or dismantled. Painting of vehicles is prohibited unless conducted inside an approved spray booth.

All vehicles MUST have a current and valid license plate and tag decal, property attached to the vehicle. Vehicles cannot be parked on grass/dirt – they must be parked on a paved surface.

Exception: Where Zoning regulations allow.
