Gwinnett County Burn Ban Now in Effect

The Gwinnett County Fire Marshal's office has ordered a ban on outdoor burning starting March 23 at 10:00 p.m. The ban is intended to free up Fire and Emergency Services personnel to be available to provide uninterrupted emergency services to our residents during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The following outdoor fires are prohibited: burning of leaves, limbs, and natural vegetation that may fall on one's property; prescribed burning; acquired structure burns; vegetative debris from storms; and weed abatement, disease, and pest prevention.

The safe use of campfires and BBQ grills is still allowed and does not require a permit. As always, people should exercise extreme caution when using grills or campfires.
