City Representatives Present ARPA Grants to Local Nonprofits

The City of Peachtree Corners announced the awarding of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding to local nonprofits.

On Friday, January 28th, Mayor Mike Mason and Councilmembers Eric Christ and Alex Wright presented the Robert D. Fowler YMCA with their award of \$500,000 during the YMCAs 25 Year Anniversary Celebration.
