Last Chance to Take Trail Survey

Our city is committed to its “Corners Connector” trail plan to connect neighborhoods and destinations and to provide residents and workers with additional recreational opportunities.

The city is currently working on a feasibility study for a proposed multi-use trail (good for walking/biking/pushing a stroller) along Crooked Creek between Spalding Drive and Holcomb Bridge Road / Peachtree Parkway.

The multi-use trail is expected to be 10-12 feet wide and may have concrete, greenway, and boardwalk sections. The photo visualization below provides an idea of what the trail may look like.

Trail amenities and programming are important components of a trail and help transform it into a linear park. Amenities may include lighting, restrooms at trailheads, benches, and educational information about area history, flora, and fauna. Programs could include community runs, Creek clean-up days, and guided trail walks.
