City Announces Shredding, Electronics Recycling Date

A free electronics recycling and paper shredding event will take place at the Peachtree Corners City Hall at 310 Technology Parkway on Saturday, April 14, from 9 a.m. to noon.

Residents of Peachtree Corners are invited to recycle electronics and shred unwanted documents. The city has hired [Proshred](#) and [eWaste-ePlanet](#) for the event.

Residents are limited to five (5) medium-size boxes of paper materials. Most electronics are free to recycle. LCD flat screen monitors are free to recycle. There is a fee for CRT (large-backed, heavy monitors or televisions) of 40 cents per-pound. E-waste staff will weigh the devices and collect payment directly. Cash or checks are accepted.
