



Staying Safe at Camp: What to Expect

Mansfield Parks and Recreation Staff have been working hard and are ready to welcome your camper this summer in an environment that meets State mandates and guidelines. The camp experience may look different, but rest assured knowing the following efforts are in place to provide the safest camp experience possible for your child(ren) and our staff.

New Pre-Registration Policy

Plan ahead! All campers must be pre-registered with all Additional Camp forms and health forms completed and returned by the Wednesday prior to the desired camp week. This includes forms for inhalers and epi-pens (self administered or otherwise). NO walk up or rolling registrations permitted. Late forms may result in refused admission into camp, and possible registration cancellation without refund. Forms are available at:

Health Screenings



All campers and employees will complete a health screening at the start of each camp day. This will include a temperature check and series of health questions. Parents of children enrolled must sign a consent form detailing that they understand the risks associated with COVID-19.

Emphasis on Hygiene



Campers and employees will be encouraged to wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds (sing your ABC's), especially after using the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing their nose, coughing, or sneezing. Hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol will be available when soap and water are not readily accessible.

Wearing of Masks

Counselors and employees are required to wear face coverings.

Campers are encouraged to wear face coverings (from home) as tolerated.



Surface Disinfecting

Play equipment, eating and activity tables, and any supplies will be cleaned and sanitized in compliance with CDC guidelines between each group use.

Social Distancing

Groups will be limited to 10 people and will remain the same through the duration of the camp program week.



Groups will be at least 14 feet apart from other groups at all times, including during indoor activities. When inside, groups of 10 will be assigned their own designated space
