Your child is applying to be part of a very exciting program, the Law and Leadership Summer Institute. This program meets from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday from June 24 through July 27 and will culminate with a statewide event on Saturday, July 28th, 2019. Your child will learn about Criminal Law, take field trips, meet attorneys and judges, and perform in a mock trial, all with the goal of developing your child's academic skills and, ultimately, to start preparing him or her for the rigors of high school and, eventually, college.
