Protecting Your Organization From Computer Crime

Michael Bazzell has been investigating computer crimes on behalf of the government for more than 20 years. During the majority of that time, he was assigned to the FBI's Cyber Crimes Task Force where he focused on online investigations and open source intelligence (OSINT) collection. As an active investigator, Bazzell has been involved in major criminal investigations including online child solicitation, child abduction, kidnapping, cold-case homicide, terrorist threats, and computer intrusions. Bazzell also served as the technical advisor for the television hacker drama "Mr. Robot". His books "Open Source Intelligence Techniques" and "Hiding from the Internet" have been best sellers in the United States and Europe. Bazzell currently works and resides in Washington, D.C., and serves as an advisor for the privacy app Sudo.
