The Primary Classroom Assistant works hand in hand with the classroom's Lead Teacher and as part of a Primary classroom team in preparing and maintaining a work environment consistent with the Montessori Method of learning and teaching.

The role of the Primary Classroom Assistant includes assisting the Lead Teacher with managing a classroom students ages 3-6, supporting students' independent work, handling logistical needs of the classroom, and supervising students in the indoor and outdoor environments. The Primary Classroom Assistant contributes to the Primary curriculum by providing weekly lessons in Handwriting. All MMS staff members have daily cleaning duties.

The position requires attendance at occasional evening school events and monthly after school staff meetings

The ideal candidate:

- has a background in education and enjoys working with students ages 3 to 6
- is able to ensure the physical and emotional safety and well-being of the students
