GRANT PROGRAM

Thanks to the generous financial contributions of people like you, the Education Foundation of New Berlin awarded more than \$8,000 to teachers, staff and administration in the district to start new classroom initiatives and fund school-based projects. Our inaugural competitive grant program funded the following initiatives:

- Flexible learning space for third graders at Ronald Reagan has created a more interactive learning space, particularly for completing their science experiments.
- Book Clubs in Ronald Reagan's fourth grade received up-to-date, culturally responsive, and level-appropriate books for their active readers.
- World Music Instruments at Eisenhower Middle/High School enable students of all musical abilities to explore sound and rhythm as a way to develop confidence, creativity and community.

PARENT UNIVERSITY LECTURE SERIES

Parent University Lecture Series, presented by the School District and sponsored by the Foundation, enables parents to engage with experts as they discuss various topics that parents experience with their students to help meet students' social-emotional learning and mental health needs.
