General Expectations

- Uniforms are required **daily for grades K–8**
 - P.E. uniforms are worn on assigned days
 - All clothing should be **labeled with your child's name or initials**
 - Parents are responsible for ensuring uniforms are worn **correctly and completely**
- 🚫 Important Update:
Uniform items with the *Communion of Saints (COS) logo* are no longer permitted.
All uniform pieces must display the Saint Ann School logo.

Girls Uniform

Grades K–3

- **Jumper:** Plaid #121 (knee length)
- **Pants/Shorts:** Khaki or navy (no cargo/jeggings)
- **Tops:** White or hunter green polo (logo required)
- **Socks:** White, navy, or black (no ankle socks)
- **Hosiery:** Solid white, navy, or hunter green
- Optional: White blouse under jumper

Grades 4–8

- **Skirt/Skort:** Plaid #121 (no shorter than 1 inch above knee)
- **Pants/Shorts:** Khaki or navy (no cargo/jeggings)
- **Tops:** White or hunter green polo (logo required)
- **Socks:** White, navy, or black (no ankle socks)
- **Hosiery:** Solid white, navy, or hunter green

★ Grades 6–8 (Quarters 2 & 3):

- Must wear logo outerwear (quarter-zip, sweater, vest, or cardigan)

Boys Uniform

Grades K–3

- **Pants/Shorts:** Khaki or navy (worn at waist)
- **Top:** White or hunter green polo (tucked in)
- **Socks:** White, navy, or black (no ankle socks)

Grades 4–8

- **Pants/Shorts:** Khaki or navy (belt required)
- **Top:** Polo (tucked in)
- **Socks:** White, navy, or black (no ankle socks)

★ Grades 6–8 (Quarters 2 & 3):

- White Oxford shirt + solid tie required



Shoes for Boys & Girls

Allowed:

- **Solid colors:** brown, navy, tan, gray, white, black, hunter green
- Loafers, Sperrys, sneakers, Mary Janes

Not Allowed:

- Crocs, sandals, flip-flops, boots, light-up shoes

Outerwear (During School Day)

- Must have **school logo**
- Colors: gray or hunter green
- Non-uniform hoodies are **not permitted**



Physical Education Uniform

- **Top:** School logo t-shirt (gray or green)
- **Bottoms:** Logo sweatpants or mesh shorts (seasonal)
- **Shoes:** Solid-color sneakers



Accessories & Appearance

Jewelry

- **One** watch, bracelet, ring, and **religious** necklace
- **No smartwatches**
- Girls: Small stud earrings **only**
- Boys: **No** earrings

Hair & Grooming

- Neat, natural styles only
- No extreme cuts or unnatural colors
- No hats or bandanas

Girls:

- Simple hair accessories allowed
- Nail polish permitted (no acrylics or makeup)

Boys:

- Hair above collar
- Grades 6–8: clean-shaven
