- Professor and Inaugural Chair (September 1, 2022) of the Department of Ophthalmology and Visual Sciences at The University of New Mexico School of Medicine
- Formerly the Cogan Professor of Ophthalmology, member of the PhD Program in Virology, Vice Chair for Education, Director of Diversity and Inclusion, Associate Director of the Cornea and Refractive Surgery Service, Associate Director of the Infectious Disease Institute, Director of the Ocular Burn Service and Director of Boston Keratoprosthesis, Harvard Medical School and Massachusetts Eye and Ear
- Key author for the American Academy of Ophthalmology web pages on COVID-19, which garnered over 1.5 million views during the pandemic
- Served as Chair of the Anterior Eye Disease NIH Study Section, and as a Member of the National Advisory Eye Council; and is currently Chair of the FDA Dermatologic and Ophthalmic Drugs Advisory Committee
- Recipient of the Alcon Research Institute Award and four awards from Research to Prevent Blindness
- Internationally known for his work on viral genomics and pathogenesis, corneal biology, severe ocular surface diseases, and for development of new keratoprosthesis designs for severe corneal blindness
