Subject: Upcoming scheduled milling & asphalt paving work

Dear Resident,

Sevenson Environmental Services (SES) will conduct milling and paving operations throughout Birchly Ct., Oakmont Ct., and Woodlane Dr. beginning on **Monday, April 4, 2022** concluding by **Wednesday, April 6, 2022** (weather dependent).

Safety is of utmost importance to SES during the milling and asphalt paving operations. The school district and bus company have already been contacted about road closures to Woodlane Drive expected on Wednesday April 6th. Residents with children should expect communication from the district in regards to temporarily moving the bus stops to the intersections of Woodlane Drive and Crown Point Road and Woodlane Drive and Hessian Ave, respectively, for both Tuesday April 5th and Wednesday April 6th. Traffic control from WDPD and onsite Sevenson laborers will be provided to ensure everyone remains safe during the entire work process. All paving activities should be completed by the end of the day on Wednesday April 6, 2022 (weather permitting).

The anticipated sequence of milling and paving operations to be provided by Renda Roads, Inc., are as follows:

MONDAY APRIL 4, 2022:

Birchly Court- will be milled of all asphalt. Residents intending to leave their house should have their vehicle staged on Woodlane Drive NO LATER THAN 7AM Monday morning with no vehicles parked in the Court. Birchly Court will be base coated by 6 PM with residents being able to drive on the asphalt and into driveways as needed for the night once the asphalt temperatures/conditions reach NJDOT traffic standards.

Oakmont Court- can expect milling operations to begin in the PM. Residents intending to leave should park their vehicles on Woodlane Drive but not between Hessian Avenue and Oakmont Court as this area may be milled as well, if time allows. Residents will be able to return to their driveways when milling has been completed for the day.

TUESDAY APRIL 5, 2022:

Woodlane Drive- will be milled the entire length from Hessian Avenue to Crown Point Road with half of Woodlane Drive to be paved from Hessian Avenue to the midpoint. Residents that anticipate leaving after 7AM are encouraged to park on Birchly Court, Crown Point Road or at the Verga Fire Department. Woodlane Drive will be open to traffic in the milled only areas and in the evening for newly placed asphalt, once the asphalt temperatures/conditions reach NJDOT traffic standards.

Oakmont Court-Will be paved this day. Any resident who plans on leaving after 7AM will need to park at the Verga Fire Department. Oakmont Court will be open to traffic in the PM once asphalt temperatures/conditions reach NJDOT traffic standards.

WEDNESDAY APRIL 6, 2022:

Birchly Court & Woodlane Drive- The remainder of Woodlane Drive from Crown Point Road to be paved along with Birchly Court. Any resident intending to leave

at any point Wednesday after 7AM until the evening hours, will need to park on Crown Point Road, the newly paved portion of Woodlane Drive, Oakmont Court, or at the Verga Fire Department. There is the possibility that portions of the roadway will be opened up throughout the day once asphalt temperatures/conditions allow for travel, enabling residents to park in their driveways, but may there's no guarantee of this until well be into the evening hours. All roadways will be opened once the asphalt has met NJDOT traffic standards.

Special arrangements can be made if someone requires special assistance getting to your residence, please inform us in advance, if possible. If special assistance is needed with an inoperable vehicle which may need to be moved, please let us know as well. Our focus remains on providing a quality product while ensuring the safety of all residents and employees involved with the project.

Although roadways will be open as soon as possible, we advise residents to try and refrain from extended parking on newly placed asphalt for 5 days to ensure adequate curing time. Any vehicles, trailers, or heavier equipment anticipated to be parked for an extended period of time should also refrain from parking on newly placed asphalt for a couple months.
