

## **STATE ROUTE 4 – OVERLENGTH VEHICLE ADVISORY** **VEHICLES 34-FEET LONG OR MORE ADVISED TO SEEK ALTERNATE ROUTE DURING CONSTRUCTION AT OLD RIVER BRIDGE**

### **SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY –**

Caltrans has announced that due to various construction activities which include automated flaggers and limited turning radius on State Route 4 at the Old River Bridge, vehicles measuring over 34-feet in length are strongly recommended to seek alternate routes.



In an effort to reduce potential traffic incidents, unintended traffic delays and improve safety for motorists and roadside workers during construction, overlength vehicles are strongly recommended to travel on State Route 12 or Interstate 205 as highway alternatives for travel between the city of Stockton and the town of Discovery Bay.

Construction began on the SR-4 Old River Bridge Additional Maintenance project on February 1, with estimated completion in November 2026. This bridge maintenance and preservation project will make necessary upgrades and repairs of the Old River Bridge, located at the San Joaquin/Contra Costa County line, east of Discovery Bay.

### **REQUIRED HIGHWAY CLOSURE INFORMATION:**

- Long-term, 24-hour, one-way traffic control will be implemented on SR-4 at the Old River Bridge beginning Monday, February 2, through November 2026.



**BE WORK ZONE ALERT**





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- Alternating traffic signals (automated flaggers) have been installed at the east and west ends of the Old River Bridge to control traffic and to allow safe passage for motorists.
- This extended one-way traffic control is required due to various factors including limited availability of safe workspace (no median or shoulders to perform work or stage equipment), environmental and in-water work date restrictions.
- Long-term closure of the Old River Bridge swing-span to marine traffic beginning January 25, through July 24, 2026. Boaters will need to seek an alternate waterway route during this closure.

Caltrans is utilizing roadside and portable changeable message signs to alert motorists of the lane closure and potential delays, which are expected to be approximately 15 minutes. 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


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
