AN ACT CONCERNING THE RELEASE OF RETAINAGE WITHHELD IN PRIVATE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. Section 42-158k of the general statutes is repealed and the
- 2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2017*):
- 3 No construction contract may provide for any retainage in an
- 4 amount that exceeds five per cent of the estimated amount of a
- 5 progress payment for the life of the construction project. All retainage
- 6 shall be paid by the owner not later than thirty days after the issuance
- 7 of a certificate of final completion by the owner or the owner's
- 8 authorized representative or not later than thirty days after the
- 9 equivalent written acceptance of the construction project work by the
- 10 owner.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
