

Hats Not Hate: Ribbed Bottom- Knit Flat



Materials: 1—100g ball Encore
Worsted

Needles: US 8 needles

Gauge- 18 sts and 22 rows = 4”
over st st.

Size

Age 5-7 (Age 8-10, Adult)

Circumference: 16” (18”, 20”)

Height: 8.5 (9, 10)”

Pattern

Loosely cast on 74 (82, 90) sts.

Work in 2x2 ribbing as follows:

Row 1(RS): K2, *(p2, k2); repeat
from * across.

Row 2(WS): P2, *(k2, p2); repeat
from * across.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 – 2 (3, 4) more times for a total of 6 (8, 10) rows. End with a WS row, and decrease or increase as needed on last row of ribbing to get 73 (82, 91) sts.

Begin working in st st, until total length of hat measures 6.5 (7, 8)”, ending with a WS row.

Begin decreasing as follows:

Row 1: *(K7, k2tog); repeat from * across to last st, end k1.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: *(K6, k2tog); repeat from * across to last st, end k1.

Row 4: Purl.

Row 5: *(K5, k2tog); repeat from * across to last st, end k1.

Row 6: P1, *(p2tog, p4); repeat from * to end of row.

Row 7: *(K3, k2tog); repeat from * across to last st, end k1.

Row 8: P1, *(p2tog, p2); repeat from * to end of row.

Row 9: *(K1, k2tog); repeat from * across to last st, end k1.

Row 10: P1, *(p2tog); repeat from * to end of row.

Cut yarn, leaving 18” tail; pull it through remaining stitches. Pull up tight and anchor to the inside. Sew up side seam. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations: K = knit, p = purl, k2tog = knit 2 sts together, p2tog = purl 2 sts together, st(s) = stitch(es), RS = right side, WS = wrong side.
