

Hats Not Hate- Ribbed Bottom- in the Round



Materials: 1—100g ball Encore Worsted

Needles: US 8 circular needles (16" length), US 8 double-pointed needles (set of 4), one stitch marker.

Gauge: 18 sts and 22 rows = 4" over st st.

Size:

Child (adult small, adult large)

Circumference: 18 (20, 22)"

Height: 8 (9, 10)"

Pattern

Loosely cast on 72 (80, 88) sts.

Taking care not to twist the stitches, join into a round and place marker at the beginning of the round. Work in 2x2 ribbing (K2, p2 around) for 6 (8, 10) rounds.

For largest 2 sizes only: Increase to 72 (81, 90) sts on last round of ribbing.

Work in St st in the round (knit every round) until total length of hat measures 6.5 (7, 8)".

Begin decreasing as follows, switching to double-pointed needles when needed.

Round 1: *(K7, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: *(K6, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 4: Knit.

Round 5: *(K5, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 6: Knit.

Round 7: *(K4, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 8: Knit.

Round 9: *(K3, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 10: *(K2, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 11: *(K1, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 12: *(k2tog); repeat from * around.

Cut yarn, leaving 6" tail; pull it through remaining stitches. Pull up tight and anchor to the inside. Weave in ends.
