

## **Jewelspun Cabled Hat & Ribbed Cowl**



**Materials:** 1 – 200g ball  
Jewelspun makes both pieces.  
Shown in color 847.

**Needles:**

**Hat:** 16" circulars size US 7 & 8;  
double points size US 8; cable  
needle, stitch marker.

**Cowl:** 24" circ size US 11, stitch  
marker.

**Gauge:**

**Hat:** 4 sts = 1" over st st on larger  
needles.

**Cowl:** 3.5 sts = 1" over rib pattern  
on size US 11 needles.

**Cowl size:** ~28" around x 11" tall

**Begin Hat:**

**Twisted ribbing:** \*(K1tbl, p1); repeat around.

**C6B:** Place next 3 sts onto cable needle, hold in back of work; work k3 sts, k3 sts from cable  
needle.

With smaller needles, loosely cast on 84 sts. Place marker and join to work in the round, taking  
care not to twist the sts.

Begin working in Twisted ribbing for 2", increasing to 108 sts on last round with smaller needles  
by working: \*(K3, M1, k2, p1, M1, p1); repeat from \* around: 108 sts: 12 repeats of 9 sts.

Change to larger circular needle (size 8), and begin cable pattern:

Rounds 1- 4: \*(K6, p3); repeat from \* around.

Round 5: \*(C6B, p3); repeat from \* around.

Rounds 6- 8: \*(K6, p3); repeat from \* around.

Repeat rounds 1- 8--- 3 more times for a total of 4 cable crosses.

Work rounds 1- 2 and begin decreases.

Abbreviations: K = knit, p = purl, st(s) – stitch(es), ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit,  
knit them together in that position, k2tog = knit 2 sts together, tbl = through the back loop, M1 = make 1  
= place bar between last st and next st onto needle and knit into back of it to increase 1 st.

Decreases: Change to double pointed needles when needed.

Round 1: \*(K6, p2tog, p1); repeat from \* around.

Round 2: \*(K6, p2), repeat from \* around.

Round 3: \*(C6B, p2); repeat from \* around. (last cable cross)

Round 4: \*(K6, p2); repeat from \* around.

Round 5: \*(K6, p2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 6: \*(K6, p1); repeat from \* around.

Round 7: \*(SSK, k4, p1); repeat from \* around.

Round 8: \*(K3, k2tog, p1); repeat from \* around.

Round 9: \*(SSK, k2, p1); repeat from \* around.

Round 10: \*(K1, k2tog; p1); repeat from \* around.

Round 11: \*(SSK, p1); repeat from \* around.

Round 12: \*(K2tog); repeat from \* around: 12 sts.

Round 13: \*(K2tog); repeat from \* around: 6 sts.

Cut yarn thread through remaining sts. Pull up tight and anchor. Weave on all ends.

**Begin Cowl:**

With size US 11 circular, loosely cast on 100 sts. Join, taking care not to twist.

**Round 1:** \*(K2, p2); repeat from \* around.

**Round 2:** K1, p2. \*(K2, p2); repeat from \* to last st, end k1.

Repeat rounds 1 & 2 until total length is about 11" or desired length, leaving enough yarn for a loose bind off. Bind off very loosely in rib pattern. Use a larger needle if needed.

Weave in all ends.

Abbreviations: K = knit, p = purl, st(s) – stitch(es), ssk = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together in that position, k2tog = knit 2 sts together, tbl = through the back loop, M1 = make 1 = place bar between last st and next st onto needle and knit into back of it to increase 1 st.
