



Redwood Road Restriping

12600 South to 9000 South

A UDOT Project

The Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) is restriping Redwood Road between 12600 South in Riverton and 9000 South in South Jordan. The project will utilize the existing roadway shoulders; converting them into additional travel lanes.

Project information was distributed and an open house was held during the environmental study phase of the project last spring. The environmental study is now complete and construction is anticipated to start on **April 8**.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

The project will remove the existing lane striping on Redwood Road and restripe the roadway to accommodate three lanes in each direction. Crews will work during **daytime and night time hours Monday – Friday** with occasional weekend work. Please expect:

- Noise
- Shifting lanes
- Lane closures
- Travel delays
- Temporary changes to residential and business access

In addition, the following adjustments will be made:

- **On-street parking:** on street parking along Redwood Road will be eliminated.
- **Mail delivery:** UDOT is working with the local post offices to relocate many of mailboxes along Redwood Road. The post office will notify you of your new mailbox location.
- **UTA bus stops:** UTA bus service will be maintained during construction. If any temporary closure of bus stops is required, information will be posted at the bus stop itself.
- **Garbage collection:** place garbage and recycling cans on top of the curb for collection. There will no longer be a shoulder along Redwood Road to place garbage cans on.
- **Bike lanes:** in coordination with the bike community and local cities, designated bike lanes along Redwood Road will be relocated to 1300 West and 2700 West.

Safety is a top priority for UDOT. Please stay out of the construction zone, use caution around equipment, obey all signage and allow work trucks in and out of travel lanes on Redwood Road.

Work activities and schedules may change due to weather or other events. Construction is anticipated to be complete in late May. **For more information and/or to receive project email updates, please contact us by phone or email listed below.**
