Papers must be returned by 4:00 PM on September 15th for all offices.

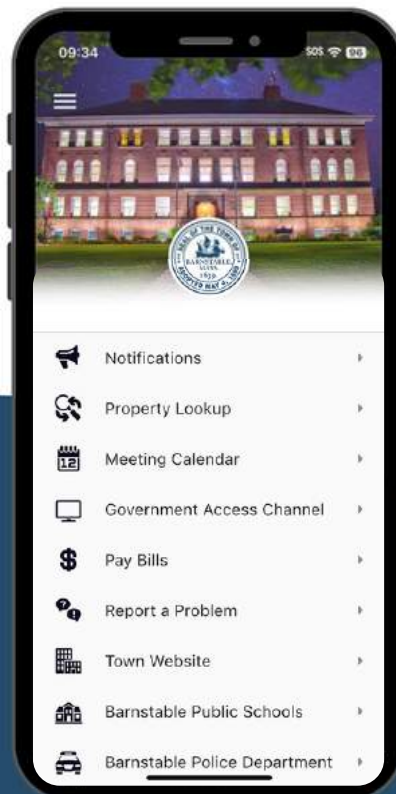

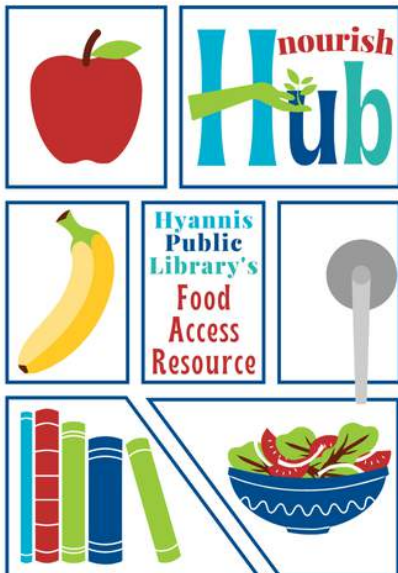
