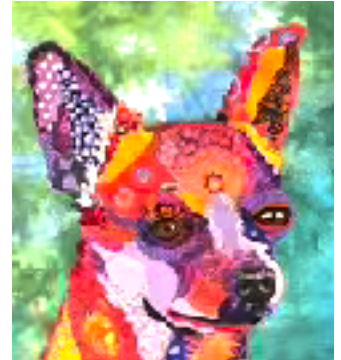


Abstract Animal Collage.

Supply List

- 8 ½ " x 11" photo of the animal face in color and black and white. You may need to crop this to center the face, and then enlarge to fill the page. Your choice of subject, it can be an animal, pet, bird, reptile etc. Email me if you need help choosing the photo. janehhaworth@gmail.com
- If you prefer to work from one of my patterns let me know your preference.
- **Important:** Take this photo to a printer shop and get a black and white enlargement at 250 -300% (about a 30" quilt) It might feel large here! **Have them print it on their regular blueprint paper.** We will use this as the base for the pattern.
- Choose a bright, colorful, abstract color scheme, consider complementary colors, i.e. two color families. Bring a range of values in the colors you choose. Small pieces and some larger. Adding some unusual colors, textures, small scale prints, batiks will add interest to the quilt. I encourage students to share fabrics since such small pieces are used. Include natural colors for the eyes and nose.
- If you choose to work in natural colors bring fabrics to match the colors in the photo. Bring all values.
- Small pieces of black, white and neutrals for eyes and nose. Also colored fabric pieces for the eyes .
- Pencil, Chalk pencil or similar fabric marking tools. Disappearing ink pen works. (I use the Bohin chalk pencil, red one)
- Black permanent marker Sharpie Fine (not ultra-fine)
 - Scissors, sharp and good for cutting small pieces of fabric. I use KKB 6" perfect scissors
- Fabric glue, I use Alennes Original Tacky Glue. Can be glue bottle with needle dispenser. Tool for applying glue like a toothpick or I have glue applicators for sale.
- Optional : Tweezers
- Optional : Light box or light pad. Can be rechargeable or battery powered.

- Small trash bag and small ziplock for off-cuts.
- Background fabric approx $\frac{3}{4}$ yd. Consider your background options, I usually choose this after the portrait is made. Look for good contrast.
